**UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES
ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

Students receiving a **Texas Wildlife Association Foundation, Inc.** and **San Antonio Livestock Exposition, Inc.** **Natural Resource-Excellence In Education Scholarship** must comply with the following guidelines:

- Must be a resident of Texas and graduate of a Texas high school
- Must be enrolled in a Texas accredited college or university with a natural resource/agricultural degree program and be classified as a “Freshman” or in first year after high school in the accredited program.
- Must be a citizen of the United States and provide a valid social security number
- Major in a natural resource related field (ag science, wildlife science, forestry, range science, etc.)
- Any change in a major must be in writing to the S.A.L.E., Inc. Scholarship Coordinator
- Maintain 12 hours per semester and a minimum 2.0 GPA per semester and 2.5 cumulative GPA.

**DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED
(please place in the order listed):**

- **One completed scholarship application**
- **Copy of high school transcript**
- **Two letters of recommendation (may be emailed from reference if necessary)**
- **Essays**
- **All required documentation should be submitted in one packet to the TWA office.**

- Participation in activities, internships, and experience related to the field of natural resource conservation.
- Honors, awards, and leadership skills
- Answers to essay questions
- Degree plan option and academic achievements
- Postmarked by **September 14, 2010**

Payment:

- Prior to receiving payment for scholarships, all recipients will be required to sign and return a completed S.A.L.E. Scholar Information Form, Requirements and Criteria Form and Release of Image Rights Form to the S.A.L.E Scholarship Coordinator.
- Funds will reside with the San Antonio Livestock Exposition, Inc. and will be paid directly to the college or university designated by the recipient for the benefit of that recipient. Funds will be disbursed at the beginning of each semester at the rate of one-eighth (1/8) of the total amount of the scholarship per semester. No funds will be paid directly to a student.
- Recipients, who do not attend college, do not pursue a degree in agriculture or an agriculture related field, fail to maintain academic standards or college enrollment will forfeit their scholarship. All remaining funds will revert to the S.A.L.E., Inc. Scholarship Fund.
